## T+L GUIDE TO TODOS SANTOS

### STAY

Snag one of the eight rooms at the Todos Santos Inn (33 Calle Legaspi; 52-612/145-0040; [www.todossantosinn.com](http://www.todossantosinn.com); doubles from \$125), in a 19th-century hacienda.

### EAT

The owner himself whips up killer margaritas and rellenos in his sand-floored shack, Miguel's (corner of Degollado and Rangel; no phone; dinner for two \$40).

### SHOP

For stylish—and cheap—serapes and silver jewelry, there's Mango's (Calle Centenario; no phone).

### ONE STOP

In the center of town, the revamped Hotel California (Calle Juárez; 52-612/145-0525; [www.hotelcaliforniabaja.com](http://www.hotelcaliforniabaja.com); doubles from \$125) has it all: a funky bar, an open-air restaurant, a boho-chic store, and 11 colorful rooms to rent.
